**HISTORY:**

- 1926, 22 June      The Moravian Mission had agreed to lease its trading stations in Labrador to the Hudson's Bay Company for 21 years and had accepted the Company's offer of £22,000 for merchandise, equipment and the mission ship *Harmony* (A.1/215, fo. 126).
- 1926                  Sailed from Dartmouth, U.K. to Labrador Posts, returning to Ardrossan.
- 1927, January      Hudson's Bay Company decided to register under name of *Bayharmony*.
- 1927, April         Sold for scrap. The ship breakers, Turner and Hickman of Glasgow, sent figure head to Moravian Mission in London.
