On motion of Hon. Ms. BLADY, Bill (No. 52) – The Non-Smokers Health Protection Amendment Act (Prohibitions on Flavoured Tobacco and Other Amendments)/Loi modifiant la Loi sur la protection de la santé des non-fumeurs (interdiction visant le tabac aromatisé et autres modifications), was read a First Time and had its purposes outlined.

The following petitions were presented and read:

Mr. EWASKO – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government and the Minister of Health to ensure that the Beausejour District Hospital and Primary Care Centre have a primary care physician available on weekends and holidays to better provide area residents with this essential service. (D. Chura, C. Zillman, L. Litke and others)

Mr. EICHLER – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government to reverse the job-killing PST increase and to restore the right of Manitobans to reject or approve any increases to the PST through a referendum. (M. Abrahams, T. Tarrant, E. Tarrant and others)

Mr. CULLEN – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government to reverse the PST increase and to restore the right of Manitobans to vote in a referendum on increases to the PST. (M. Jamieson, B. Jewsbury, T. Drinkwater and others)

Mr. GRAYDON – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government and the Minister of Jobs and the Economy to increase the rental allowance for EIA recipients to 75% of median market rent so that EIA recipients can secure clean, safe and affordable housing without sacrificing other necessities such as food and medical expenses. (A. Stoesz, W. Friesen, C. Doell and others)

Mr. PEDERSEN – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge that the Minister responsible for Manitoba Hydro create a complete and transparent "Needs For And Alternatives To" review of Manitoba Hydro's total capital development plan to ensure the financial viability of Manitoba Hydro. (D. Laudin, J. Kaminsky, W. Kaminsky and others)

Mr. SMOOK – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government to reverse the PST increase and to restore the right of Manitobans to vote in a referendum on increases to the PST. (L. Woywoda, J. Wolanski, D. Catellier and others)
